

Motion

The Faculty Senate recommends that the Vice Provost for Academic Affairs act with regards to the Core Curriculum in the manner of a College Dean as outlined in sections 1.4.2 and 4.1.3.1 of the T & R Faculty Handbook.

Rationale:

Currently there is no infrastructure for the evaluation of the Director and Core Curriculum Coordinators. This motion creates a path for evaluation of the administrators of the Core. Written evaluations of the Director would come from GECAC/CCAC and then move to the Vice Provost, following a path parallel to a department chair's evaluation first by her/his personnel committee and then by the dean of her/his college. Core Coordinators would be evaluated first by the Director of the Core, then GeCAC/CACC acting in the manner of a Personnel Committee, and then by the Vice Provost, again following a path parallel to a faculty member's evaluation.
