

## **Motion Recommending that GECAC/CCAC act with regards to UNIV Core 201 and 202 in the manner of a Department Personnel Committee**

The Faculty Senate recommends that GECAC/CCAC act with regards to UNIV Core 201 and 202 in the manner of a Department Personnel Committee with its duties including some of those outlined under section 4.2.3.3 of the T & R Faculty Handbook, and specifically including:

- Electing a sub-committee of no less than three tenured faculty members to fulfill the following responsibilities in a timely manner and in accordance with the University Personnel Decision Timeline:
  - Recommending reappointment or non-reappointment of Adjunct Faculty inclusive of Special Purpose, Full-time Temporary, and Part-time Faculty.
  - Administering, delivering and generally overseeing student evaluations of all faculty teaching Core 201 and 202 courses.
  - Annually evaluating and reviewing the Director as a Director. The evaluation shall be conveyed both to the Director and to the Vice Provost. Any appeal would be conducted in a manner consonant with the existing procedures outlined in the T & R Faculty Handbook.
  - Hearing and review of student grievances against faculty teaching or advising in the Core.

### Rationale:

Currently Core 201 and 202 are unaccounted for in existing personnel paths and procedures. Core 101, 102 and 103 are currently staffed and overseen by the English Department. This motion addresses a gap in the process by applying personnel procedures consistent with those outlined in the RU T & R Faculty Handbook. Further, this measure protects the integrity of instruction of University Core A courses and of faculty and student experiences.
