

MOTION: REVISION TO SECTION 1.9.5 OF THE TEACHING AND RESEARCH FACULTY HANDBOOK REGARDING FACULTY GRIEVANCE COMMITTEE COMPOSITION

Motion

The Faculty Senate recommends the following revision to Section 1.9.5 of the *Teaching and Research Faculty Handbook* (deletions in strikethrough, additions underlined):

The Faculty Grievance Committee shall consist of ten elected tenured faculty members. Representation is as follows: ~~four~~ three representatives elected from the ~~College of Arts and Sciences~~ College of Humanities and Behavioral Sciences, one from the College of Business and Economics, one from the College of Education and Human Development, one from the College of Visual and Performing Arts, ~~one~~ two from the ~~College of Information Science and Technology~~ College of Science and Technology, and one from the Waldron College of Health and Human Services. One faculty member will be elected at-large by the University faculty.

Rationale

The committee composition described in the Handbook does not reflect the current college structure, and accordingly it does not reflect the current composition of the committee. The proposed language is consistent with the current composition of the committee, and also is proportional to the number of teaching and research faculty in each college.
