The minutes of the last meeting were approved.

Agenda Items

Feedback from the University Advising Committee

The University Advising Committee raised a point about the distinction between a course as a substitute for CORE 101 or CORE 102 and a waiver of the requirement based on a course taken elsewhere. A waiver of the requirement provides students with more flexibility.

The University Advising Committee also thought that courses taken elsewhere could be substituted for CORE 201 and CORE 202 for a period of transition, say three years. After the transition period, transfers would have to take CORE 201 and CORE 202 unless the student had an appropriate VA Associate Degree, which grants the student a waiver of most general education requirements.

A motion was proposed to grant students with ENG 111 and ENG 112 credit a waiver from CORE 101 and CORE 102, respectively.

The motion was **approved**. This recommendation will go to the Faculty Senate.

Proposal from CHBS

The committee was informed that Department heads in CHBS sent a proposal to the Faculty Senate to basically move back to the general education framework based on their experience with Core Curriculum implementation difficulties. Any official discussion of this proposal will await a Faculty Senate or Provost referral to the committee.
