

Motion Regarding Faculty Morale Survey

MOTION:

The Faculty Senate recommends that revisions be made to the three open-ended comment questions on the Faculty Morale Survey, as follows:

- 1) "Comments about leadership:" will be replaced by "What aspects of RU leadership have been most effective? What changes could yield the greatest improvement?"

- 2) "Comments on campus environment:" will be replaced by "What specific aspects of campus resources and environment have been the most supportive? What changes could yield the greatest improvement?"

and

- 3) "Comments on overall satisfaction:" will be replaced by "What specific changes would you like to see at Radford University and why? What is working best at Radford University?"

RATIONALE:

By requesting specific information from faculty regarding their satisfaction with various aspects of campus leadership, environment, and satisfaction, written survey responses may be more detailed or precise in nature regarding existing strengths and areas of improvement.
